A woman who dresses up as a scantily clad superheroine named Minx no longer has to worry about getting a dressing down from DC Comics.

The "Superman" publisher had sent Andrea Grant a cease-and-desist letter earlier this year, telling her she had to drop plans to put out a "Minx" comic book because they own the trademark on the title — but now the two have kissed and made up.

"It was resolved amicably," Grant said. "I'm very pleased."

Grant said her comic would now be called "Andrea Grant's Minx."

DC had told her they didn't want her comic to be called "Minx" because they had "recently acquired" the trademark and planned to use it as "the name of a new comic book targeted to women."
